

10. Parent Letter

Dear Parents

This morning, we sought clarity regarding the State Government's decision to bring the school holidays forward for our 'students.' We can confirm that **today (Monday March 23rd)** is the last day of term for our students. Students will be collected from designated areas in the front playground at 3:30pm. **OSHClub** will operate as per usual this afternoon, however, it will not be available over the extended holiday period.

A noted point of difference with these 'additional holidays' is all staff will be required to be on-site for the remainder of the week. Staff will use the next four days to plan and prepare for a possible transition to flexible and remote learning to commence on **Tuesday 14th April** (not Wednesday 15th April as previously stated by the State Government).

As this is considered 'school holidays' for the students, staff will not be sending work home to be completed this week. In addition, please note, readers and Chromebooks will not be sent home over this extended holiday period (24th March - 13th April).

Information will follow regarding our strategic plan for remote learning and how this will be implemented with our students and families should we have to take action.
